

CERTIFICATE OF FORMATION
OF ALTADENA LIBRARY DISTRICT
OF LOS ANGELES COUNTY

I hereby certify that in accordance with the provisions of an act entitled "An act to allow unincorporated towns and villages to establish, equip, and maintain public libraries; to provide for the formation, government and operation of library districts; the acquisition of property thereby; the calling and holding of elections in such districts; the assessment, collection, custody and disbursement of taxes therein; and to create boards of library trustees." Statutes 1909, page 815, a petition praying for the formation of a library district to be known as the Altadena Library District of Los Angeles County was filed with the Board of Supervisors on the 9th day of October, 1926.

That the boundaries of the said proposed district as set forth in said petition are as follows:

"Beginning at the northwesterly corner of Lot 34 of Altadena Map No. 3, as shown on map recorded in Book 52, page 50 of Miscellaneous Records of Los Angeles County, said Northwesterly corner being an angle point, in the boundary of the City of Pasadena as the same existed on October 22, 1925; ~~thence easterly along the northerly boundary of said Altadena, to the northeasterly corner of Lot 2 of said Altadena, said northeasterly corner being a point in the southerly line of Fractional Section 4, Township 1 North, Range 2 West, S. B. M.; thence easterly along the southerly line of said fractional section and easterly and southeasterly along the southerly and southwesterly lines of Fractional Section 3, said township and range, to the most westerly corner of Lot 5, said fractional Section 3; thence easterly and southerly along the northerly and easterly lines of said last mentioned lot to the northeasterly line of Tract No. 813, as shown on map recorded in Book 17, page 182 of Maps, records of said county; thence easterly and southeasterly along the boundary of said last mentioned tract to the northerly line of Lot 6, said fractional Section 3; thence easterly in a direct line to the north-easterly corner of said last mentioned lot; thence southerly in a direct line to the northwesterly corner of Lot 8, said fractional Section 3, thence easterly~~

1 and southerly along the northerly and easterly
2 lines of said last mentioned lot to the northerly
3 lines of fractional Section 11, said township and
4 range; thence easterly along section line to the
5 X northeasterly corner of Lot 3, said last mentioned
6 fractional section, thence southerly, along the
7 easterly line of said last mentioned lot, to the
8 northerly boundary of the San Pascual Rancho, as
9 shown on map recorded in Book 1, pages 19 & 20 of
10 Patents, records of said County; thence easterly
11 along the boundary of said rancho and following the
12 same in all its various courses to the most norther-
13 ly corner of Lot B, Block C of the Bonestell Tract
14 as shown on map recorded in Book 4, page 572 of
15 Miscellaneous Records of said County; thence souther-
16 ly and westerly along the easterly and southerly
17 lines of said last mentioned lot to Station 17 in
18 the boundary of said last mentioned tract; thence X
19 westerly in a direct line to the intersection of
20 the easterly prolongation of the northerly line of
21 Lot 37, Tract No. 6433, as shown on map recorded in
22 Book 104, page 20 of Maps, records of said County,
23 with the easterly line of Foot Hill Boulevard (former-
24 ly Santa Anita Avenue), as shown on said last
25 mentioned map; thence westerly in a direct line to
26 the northwesterly corner of Lot 411 said last
27 mentioned tract; thence northerly in a direct line
28 to the northwesterly corner of said last mentioned
29 tract, being a point in the northerly line of Lot 2,
30 Block C of Tract No. 875, as shown on map recorded
31 in Book 16, pages 102 & 103 of Maps, records of said
County; thence westerly and northwesterly along the
southerly and southwesterly lines of New York Avenue
as shown on said last mentioned map to the northeaster-
ly corner of Lot 12, Tract No. 7010 as shown on map
recorded in Book 74, page 77 of Maps, records of said
County; thence northwesterly in a direct line through
the most easterly corner of Lot 1, said last mentioned
tract to the easterly prolongation of the southerly
line of New York Avenue, as shown on map of Tract No.
4256, recorded in Book 46, page 56 of Maps, records
of said County; thence westerly in a direct line to
the northeasterly corner of Tract No. 1345, as shown
on map recorded in Book 18, pages 134 & 135 of Maps,
records of said County; thence southerly along the
easterly line of said last mentioned tract to the
easterly prolongation of the northerly line of Lot
7, said last mentioned tract; thence westerly in a
direct line through the northwesterly corner of Lot
3, said last mentioned tract to the center line of
Hill Avenue, as shown on said last mentioned map;
thence in a general southerly direction along said
last mentioned center line to the northerly line of
the aforesaid boundary of the City of Pasadena; thence
westerly along said last mentioned boundary and
following the same in all its various courses to
the point of beginning."

That thereafter the Board of Supervisors of the
County of Los Angeles, ordered an election to be held in the

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said proposed district for the determination of the question of the formation of said district, and appointed three electors thereof to conduct said election.

December
That at said election held on the 6th day of November, 1926, conducted in accordance with the provisions of said act and in accordance with the general election laws of this state where applicable, a majority of the votes cast at said election were in favor of the establishment of said district.

That within five days subsequent to said election the election officers reported the result of said election to the Board of Supervisors of Los Angeles County. That thereafter on the 8th day of December, 1926, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles found, determined and declared that at said election 332 votes were cast, of which 209 votes were cast for the establishment of the proposed district and 123 votes were cast against the establishment of said district, that a majority of the votes cast at said election were in favor of the establishment of said district and further declared that the Altadena Library District of Los Angeles County was duly established and said order and declarations were duly entered in the minutes of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles at Book 113, page 159. That thereafter the Board of Supervisors of the County of Los Angeles duly appointed Mrs. Zane Grey, Mr. Joseph H. Tumbach and Mr. Wm. D. Davies, and the appointment of said trustees was duly entered in the minutes of said Board at Book 113, page 159. That thereafter the said Board of Library Trustees of the Altadena Library District at its first meeting held at
Altadena, California,
elected the following officers for the current fiscal
